

# Bed Bug Preparation Sheet

**\*Please be prepared to vacate the premises for 4 hours once treatment is complete**

**\*Anyone suffering from with respiratory problems to consider vacating for 24 hours**

1. *Please have all dresser drawers empty and have all of the linens bagged.*
2. *These bagged linens do not have to be laundered immediately, however, they must be prior to placing them back in to the drawers after the second treatment.*
3. *Please remove all clothing from closets unless they are hanging and that the closet floor is free of debris.*
4. *Please have all sheets and pillow cases removed from all beds (including sofa beds) and bagged.*
5. *Please ensure all bedside tables (drawers) are empty from any items.*
6. *All linens should be laundered and then placed in the dryer on medium to high temperature for a minimum of 30 minutes. If there is an item that cannot be washed, place it in the dryer for 60 minutes on medium to high temperature.*
7. *Vacuum all floor areas (carpet/hardwood) and dispose of bag immediately in an outside garbage bin.*
8. *Any bags/purses that have been used for travel over the last 6 weeks should be left out for treatment.*
9. *Wall units do not need to be prepared and may be left as they are.*
10. *Please cover any aquariums with a damp towel and have the pump turned to the off position.*
11. *Clear all kitchen counters of food and store them in the cupboard or fridge.*
12. *Empty any animal dishes (food/water).*
13. *Where applicable, please remove smoke detector(s) and/or contact monitoring Alarm Company and have the smoke alarms turned off for a 4-hour period during treatment.*
14. *Upon re-entry please wipe down all kitchen counters and table tops*
15. *Please schedule a follow up treatment for 14 days or thereafter initial treatment*
16. *No vacuum or wet mopping of the treated areas for 7-10 days after each treatment.*

**\*Please have your unit prepared the same way for your follow up treatment**
